- 3% Controlling crime and drugs
- 3% Protecting our air and water
- 0% Improving the quality of roads and bridges

__12. Have you ruled out voting for Rick Snyder the Republican and are pretty certain that you will vote for Virg Bernero the Democrat, or, are you still considering Rick Snyder and might change your mind and vote for him?

- 70% Ruled out Snyder and certain to be voting for Bernero
- 28% Still considering Snyder and may change mind
- 2% Undecided/Don't know/Refused

__13. Using a scale of 0 to 10 where 10 means that you are extremely motivated and absolutely certain to vote, and zero means you are NOT motivated or NOT certain to vote at all, what number would you use to describe how motivated and certain you are to vote in the upcoming November general election?

Mean = 9.427 0 to 7 = 8% 8 & 9 = 14% 10 = 78%

__14. Based on your personal experience or what you know or have heard or read, do you support or oppose the efforts of the Tea Party movement? **[IF SUPPORT OR OPPOSE, ASK: 'Do you strongly or somewhat (SUPPORT/OPPOSE) the Tea Party movement?' AND CODE BEST RESPONSE]**

- 23% Strongly supports Tea Party movement
- 21% Somewhat supports Tea Party movement **44% TOTAL TEA PARTY SUPPORT**
- 9% Somewhat opposes Tea Party movement
- 26% Strongly opposes Tea Party movement **35% TOTAL TEA PARTY OPPOSITION**
- 21% Undecided/Don't know/Refused
